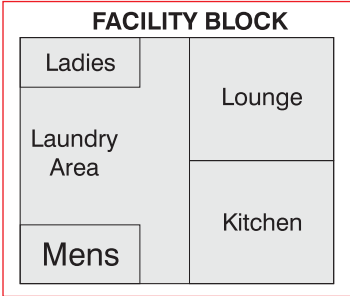


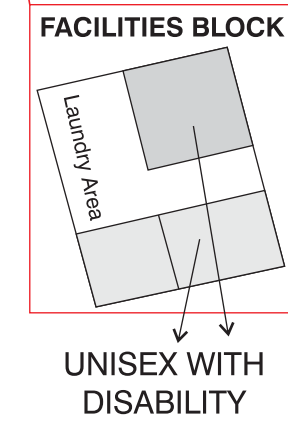

Park Rules

● **Speed limit - 5kph for safety reasons.**

● **Please watch out for children and other foot traffic.**

Noise: No noise will be tolerated after 9pm or before 8am. Please report any excessive noise by phoning 0800 580 581. Please don't wait until the following morning. We will act immediately – no matter the time.

Pet friendly: Pets are not allowed in units or shared facilities at any time. All pets brought onto the park are to be declared during check in.

- on a lead at all times
- immediately cleaned up after
- minimal level of dog noise

Bikes: Cyclists must wear a helmet at all times when cycling anywhere on our park. Bikes are not allowed inside your unit.

Behaviour: Unreasonable behaviour will not be tolerated, and offenders will be asked to leave, no refund will be given.

Smoking: please no smoking inside any accommodation units/shared facilities.

Alcohol: No alcohol is to be consumed in the main facilities/BBQ area - only within sites and cabins.

Visitors: All visitors to please report to the office due to security and safety reasons.

Rubbish: Please recycle what you can. For all non recyclables please use waste bins provided.

Dump station: Located at the end of Asphalt Road.

Vehicles: Must have valid certificate of fitness.

Site boundary: Please ensure you are within the allocated space of your site.

All guests and visitors must follow park rules and comply with all staff instructions while on site. Failure to do so will result in immediate removal from the premises, and bookings may be cancelled.

Final authority in all matters directly linked to the park and its safety rests with park management.
